Counselor Opportunity for Undergraduate Mathematics Majors

Residential mathematical immersion at Boston University: June 21-August 8, 2026

An intensive summer program for mathematically talented high school students, **PROMYS** is also designed for the mathematical development of its counselors.

- Immerse yourself for seven weeks in challenging and collaborative mathematics.
- Act as a mathematical mentor and role model, supervising the work of 3 or 4 high school students.
- Take advanced seminars and engage in mentored research on a variety of mathematical topics.
- Advance your mathematical knowledge through counselor-led seminars and minicourses.
- PROMYS creates an inspiring mathematical community of high school students, undergraduate counselors, faculty, research mentors, visiting mathematicians and guest lecturers.
- Founded in 1989, PROMYS has a large and involved alumni community.
- 77% of counselor alumni go on to earn a doctorate of which 80% are PhDs in mathematics.

Counselors receive a 7-week stipend of \$5,750, plus free room and board.

Hiring decisions made on a rolling basis starting February 1, 2026. Applications accepted through March 15.
